CO-RESPONDER MODEL UNDERWAY

A nearly \$1.6 million grant is funding a multi-county co-responder model to tackle the link between mental health and crime. Through that model, a social worker accompanies police responding to someone impaired or who possibly has mental health issues. The model can result in reduced recidivism and saving police resources to respond to more serious crime.

TENNILLE PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE

UGA College of Engineering students working through Archway created a design for a pedestrian bridge that will cross the rail line in the town square, allowing for increased access during times when trains block crossing. A \$777,000 grant from the Department of Transportation will help to continue advancing the construction process.

COMMUNITY HEALTH
