Connected Resilient Communities

The Connected Resilient Communities designation provides Georgia communities an opportunity to tap into UGA's vast resources and expertise to address local challenges and increase its potential for economic development.

Selected cities and counties use local data and community input to complete three projects to bolster community's resilience.

The Archway Partnership, a UGA Public Service and Outreach unit, facilitates the projects, connecting communities with faculty and students.

Communities will be recognized at the completion of each project. Upon completion of three projects, the community will receive the CRC designation. Each of the projects takes approximately four to six months to complete, or 12 to 18 months total.


