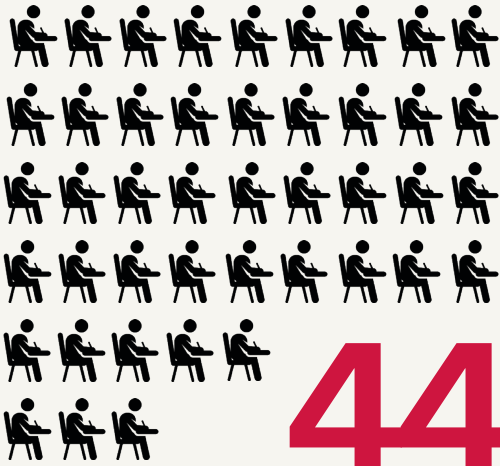

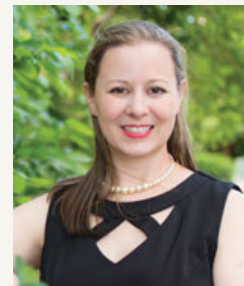


## Workforce Strategic Planning
